CITY OF CAMROSE  
PROVINCE OF ALBERTA**

**A BY-LAW OF THE CITY OF CAMROSE TO PROVIDE FOR LICENSING,  
REGULATING AND CONTROLLING TAXI BUSINESSES IN THE CITY OF  
CAMROSE.**

WHEREAS Pursuant to the provisions of the Municipal Government Act, R.S.A. 1994 Chapter M-26.1 as amended, the Council of a Municipality may pass a Bylaw for the licensing, regulating and controlling of certain businesses.

**1. Short Title:**

This By-law may be cited as the Taxi By-Law.

**2. Definitions:**

- (a) "Chief of Police" means the Chief of Camrose Police Service or his designate.
- (b) "City" means the City of Camrose;
- (c) "Council" means the Municipal Council of the City of Camrose;
- (d) "License Officer" means a person designated by the City of Camrose;
- (e) "Limousine" means a large luxurious chauffeur-driven automobile that usually has a glass partition separating the driver's seat from the passenger compartment, and is used in the business of conveying passengers for compensation in connection with special functions, but does not include a vehicle identified as a Taxi Cab.
- (f) "Passenger" means any person, other than the driver, being conveyed in a taxicab;
- (g) "Peace Officer" means any member of the Camrose Police Service;
- (h) "Security Check" means Criminal Record/Drivers license check as conducted by the Chief of Police or his designate;
- (i) "Street" means any roadway or other place where motor vehicles are, or are permitted to be, operated;
- (j) "Taxi Business License" means a license issued by the City of Camrose authorizing a person to operate a taxi cab business within the City of Camrose;
- (k) "Taxi cab" means a motor vehicle which is used or intended to be used in the business of conveying passengers to destinations designated by the passengers for which a fee or fare is charged, including Handi-vans (vans for transporting the elderly or disabled), shuttle-buses (buses for transporting large numbers of people at special events) and Limousines.
- (l) "Taxi Driver" means any person permitted to operate a taxi pursuant to this By-Law;
- (m) "Taxi Driver Permit" means a permit issued by the Chief of Police to drive a taxi cab within the City of Camrose;

**3. By-Law Compliance:**

No person shall operate a vehicle or allow his vehicle to be operated as a taxi cab without first having complied with this By-Law.

**4. Licensing of Taxi Businesses:**

- (a) No taxi business or taxi cab owner shall operate within the City of Camrose prior to obtaining a City of Camrose business license and paying a business license fee.

The taxi company or owner must establish and maintain a business office in the City or County of Camrose No. 22.

- (b) The taxi business as licensed with the City of Camrose must operate at least two licensed taxi cabs available to provide 24 hour a day, 7 day a week coverage to persons. Notwithstanding the foregoing this clause shall not apply to a limousine owner or Handi-van.
- (c) An applicant for a taxi business license shall produce, upon application of the annual renewal of the business license and at such other time as may be directed by the License Officer, the following:
  - (i) name(s) of the registered owner and drivers;
  - (ii) proof of registration of the vehicle or vehicles to be licensed;
  - (iii) make, year, colour and serial number of the vehicle(s);
  - (iv) name of the taxi company and its identifying color scheme;
  - (v) written mechanical inspection of vehicle(s)
  - (vi) a certificate from an insurance company licensed to carry on business in the Province of Alberta, showing that the applicant for the license is the holder of a subsisting policy of insurance issued by such insurer in respect of the taxi cab(s) for which the applicant intends to obtain a license to operate a taxi cab(s).
- (d) The License Officer shall issue the said taxi business license upon satisfaction of compliance with the above listed requirements of this By-Law, and payment of fee as set out in the City's Business License By-Law.
- (e) The License Officer may refuse to issue or renew a taxi business license, or may cancel or suspend a subsisting taxi business license, if in his/her opinion that there are just and reasonable grounds for refusal of the application or for cancellation or suspension of the taxi business license.

#### 5. **Taxi Driver's Permit:**

- (a) No person shall operate a taxi in the City unless he holds a subsisting Taxi Driver's permit in the form set out as Schedule "D" as attached hereto, issued or renewed pursuant to the provisions of this By-Law.
- (b) A person who desires to obtain or renew a Taxi Driver's permit shall submit to the Chief of Police a fully completed and signed application in the form set out as Schedule "A" attached to and forming part of this By-Law, together with a driver's abstract from the Motor Vehicles Branch of the Province of Alberta which is dated not more than two weeks prior to the date of the application and a completed Form B or C Request for Criminal Record Name Check which is obtained from the Chief of Police, and
  - (i) produce a valid and subsisting Alberta Operator's Licence of a Class which permits the operation of taxis within the Province of Alberta.
- (c) Upon receiving an application to obtain or renew a Taxi Driver's permit the Chief of Police shall take such steps deemed necessary to verify the accuracy of the information contained in the application and shall determine whether the applicant is a fit person to operate a taxi cab, having regard to:

- (c)
  - (i) whether the applicant has been found guilty or convicted of an offence under the Criminal Code (Canada) or under any other criminal statute of Canada or any other country, within the five years preceding the application;
  - (ii) whether the applicant has been found guilty or convicted of an offence under the Highway Traffic Act R.S.A. 1980 Chapter H-7 or the Motor Vehicle Administration Act R.S.A. 1980 Chapter M-22 or any regulation or by-Law passed under the authority of either of those statutes, or under any similar statute or regulation or By-Law of a jurisdiction other than Alberta, within the three years preceding the application; and

- (iii) any other information within the knowledge of the Chief of Police concerning the character or conduct of the applicant.
- (d) If the Chief of Police is of the opinion that the applicant is a fit person to operate a taxi cab, a Taxi Driver's permit shall be issued to the applicant or renewed as the case may be, upon receipt of payment of the fee as set out in this By-Law.
- (e) If,
  - (i) after a Taxi Driver's permit has been issued or renewed pursuant to the provisions of this section, and
  - (ii) on the basis of
    - (A) any or all of the criteria in subsection (c) of this section, or
    - (B) any non-compliance with the requirements of this By-Law

the Chief of Police decides that the holder of the Taxi Driver's permit is not a fit person to operate a taxi cab, he shall:

- (iii) cancel the Taxi Driver's permit, or
- (iv) suspend the Taxi Driver's permit for a period of time not exceeding the unexpired term of the permit; or if the suspension is for non-compliance with the requirements of this By-Law, until, in the opinion of the Chief of Police, the requirements have been complied with.
- (f) If the Chief of Police decides to refuse an application under this section or to suspend or cancel a subsisting Taxi Driver's permit, he shall notify the applicant or permit holder in writing of the refusal, suspension or cancellation, giving written reasons for the decision.
- (g) Every Taxi Driver's permit issued or renewed pursuant to the provisions of this Section shall, unless sooner suspended or cancelled by the Chief of Police cease to be subsisting on December 31st. of the year following which the Taxi Driver's permit was issued or renewed.
- (h) No person shall operate a taxi for hire unless the Taxi Driver's permit is openly displayed at all times in the taxi in such manner as to be visible to passengers.
- (i) When a Taxi Business license has been refused or cancelled or suspended in accordance with Section 4(e), the person so affected may, within 7 days, appeal such action to the Council by notifying the City Clerk of the intention to appeal
  - (i) by personally delivering or giving written notice
  - (ii) by mailing a double registered letter to the City Clerk.
- (j) Upon receipt of the appeal the Council or a Committee of the Whole Council shall conduct a hearing within seven (7) calendar days and render a decision to (a) uphold the appeal and direct that the license or permit be issued or reinstated, or (b) dismiss the appeal, and the decision shall be final.
- (k) When a Taxi Driver Permit has been refused or cancelled or suspended in accordance with Section 5(f), the person so affected may, within 7 days, appeal such action to the Chairman of the Camrose Police Commission by notifying the Chairman of the intention to appeal
  - (i) by personally delivering or giving written notice
  - (ii) by mailing a double registered letter to the Chairman of the Camrose Police Commission.

Upon receipt of the appeal the Police Commission shall conduct a hearing within seven (7) calendar days and render a decision to (a) uphold the appeal and direct that the permit be issued or reinstated, or (b) dismiss the appeal, and the decision of the Police Commission shall be final.

- (l) The holder of a Taxi Driver permit shall forthwith:
  - (i) report the loss or theft of his permit to the Camrose Police Service.
  - (ii) surrender his permit to the Camrose Police Service when he ceases his employment as a taxi cab driver in the City of Camrose, or
  - (iii) surrender his permit to the Chief of Police when such permit has been cancelled or suspended.

6. **Mechanical Inspections:**

- (a) No owner or operator of a taxi cab shall operate a taxi without first having obtained an approved mechanical inspection check, and providing same to the License Officer. An approved mechanical inspection check shall be obtained annually thereafter, before December 31st of the current year.
- (b) Each mechanical inspection check shall be carried out and shall be at the expense of the taxi owner or representative.
- (c) The said mechanical inspection check shall be in the form marked Schedule "B", attached hereto and made part of this By-Law, and shall be completed and signed by a Licensed Mechanic.
- (d) If the License Officer has reasonable grounds to believe that a Licensed Mechanic has certified a taxi when such taxi does not meet the requirements in reference to Schedule "B", the License Officer may refuse to accept the taxi cab mechanical inspection certificate signed by that Licensed Mechanic, and in addition may suspend or cancel the approval given to the business.
- (e) If the License Officer or a Peace Officer is of the opinion, at any time, that the condition of a taxi does not comply with Schedule "B", the License Officer or a Peace Officer may direct the owner or representative of the owner to have the taxi inspected by a Licensed Bus Inspector at a location specified by the License Officer or a Peace Officer, immediately, and at the expense of the Taxi owner. Refusal to abide by an order may result in immediate license suspension.
- (f) Major repairs required to comply with the Mechanical Inspection shall be done forthwith by a licensed mechanic who will certify the work has been done and a copy of the certification will be provided to the License Officer.\*

7. **Taxi Cab Appearance and Identification:**

- (a) All taxi cabs, with the exceptions of Handi-vans, Shuttle-buses and Limousines, shall prominently display on the exterior, the name of the company and phone number that the taxi cab is associated with. This includes each side of the taxi cab.
- (b) All taxi cabs, with the exceptions of Handi-vans, Shuttle-buses and Limousines shall be equipped with a light mounted on the roof of the taxi cab identifying the taxi company by name and/or telephone number.
- (c) Each taxi cab business, with the exceptions of Handi-van, Shuttle-bus and Limousine businesses, shall have each of their taxi cabs painted a similar color or color scheme, and an illuminated roof light of a colour or design, to identify the taxi company, which shall be different from the other taxi cab companies.
- (d) Once a motor vehicle has been designated as a taxi cab, by appearance and identification, the driver of that vehicle must possess a subsisting Taxi Driver's permit.

Should the need arise for the vehicle to be operated by a driver who does not possess a Taxi Driver's permit, the roof light must be covered over and a "Not For Hire" sign shall be affixed to the sun visor on the passenger side of the vehicle in such a way that it is clearly visible from the outside of the vehicle.

A person operating a taxi cab in contravention of this section is subject to an offence as set out in Section 5 of this By-Law.\*\*

- (e) Any taxi cab which does not comply with the provisions of Section 6 and Section 7 of this By-Law will be ordered removed from the Highway or subject to seizure and will not be used for hire until the License Officer deems the taxi cab to be in compliance. Costs incurred for seizure will be the responsibility of the taxi cab owner. \*\*

## 8. General Regulations:

### (a) Every taxi cab owner

- (1) shall ensure that all persons operating the taxi cab are in possession of a current and valid driver's license for the operation of a taxi cab and a current and valid Taxi Driver Permit.
- (2) or taxi cab driver shall, upon being requested by a License Officer or a Peace Officer, give full information concerning the address of a house or place to or from which any passenger has been driven by keeping an accurate updated log, including dates, times, addresses to and from, which will be retained for a period of three months.\*\*\*
- (3) shall ensure all taxi cabs operating within the City will be maintained in a clean and sanitary condition at all times.
- (4) shall ensure that each of his taxi cabs and/or lease owner/operators taxi cabs are equipped with a taxi meter or other device to properly record/or display the existing tariffs.
- (5) install the taxi meter or device in such taxi so that it is illuminated and that the fare can be read at all times by a passenger in the front and rear of such taxi cab.
- (6) shall upon demand by a License Officer or Peace Officer submit the taxi cab with the meter or device for inspection and accuracy testing.
- (7) The taxi business shall , not later than the 3rd day of each month, deliver to the Chief of Police a list of the taxi drivers employed by him as of the last day of the preceding month.
- (8) Notwithstanding the foregoing, clauses 8(a) (4), (5) and (6) shall not apply to Limousine owners, Handi-van owners, and Shuttlebus owners.

### (b) Every taxi driver shall

- (1) prominently display his Taxi Driver's permit in such a position inside the taxi that is clearly visible to all passengers in the taxi.
- (2) be neatly dressed, clean, well-behaved and courteous to passengers.
- (3) check the taxi and if he finds any article of value lost or left therein, deliver the same to the owner, if known. All unclaimed property of value shall be delivered to the Camrose Police Service and disposed of as per Camrose Police Service Policy.
- (4) unless otherwise directed by a passenger, drive passengers by the most direct practicable route to their destination.
- (5) whenever requested by a passenger, issue a receipt for the amount of the taxi fare paid by such passenger.
- (6) be entitled to refuse a person as a customer if such a person:
  - (i) is drunk or disorderly,
  - (ii) is indebted to the taxi driver or the taxi owner with which the taxi is affiliated,
  - (iii) is apparently unable to pay for the taxi service requested,
  - (iv) requests the taxi driver to carry an animal or any baggage which might be detrimental to the repair, cleanliness or sanitary condition of the taxi, with the exception of a blind person's guide dog.
  - (v) requests the taxi driver to carry any passengers or baggage which the taxi is incapable of carrying.

(c) Every Taxi Driver shall not:

- (i) operate or be in charge of a taxi cab while his ability to drive a motor vehicle is impaired by alcohol or drugs,
- (ii) carry or allow to be carried in a taxi cab, alcohol to be consumed in the taxi cab, or by the operator on duty,
- (iii) carry or allow to be carried in a taxi cab, alcohol for delivery unless the necessary permit has first been obtained from the Alberta Gaming and Liquor Commission.
- (iv) carry more, at any one time in a vehicle, than the number of passengers equal to the maximum insured capacity of the taxi cab
- (v) carry any passenger who is under the influence of any intoxicant while his taxi cab is occupied by a person who is not accompanying the person so under the influence except with the express consent of the person not so under the influence.
- (vi) smoke while a passenger is being carried by him without first having gained his or her permission.
- (vii) carry any passenger while on duty or subject to call, other than the person or persons employing his services, unless first approved by that person or persons employing his services.
- (viii) overcrowd a public taxi cab stand, nor back into the same, nor push or displace any taxi cab already at the stand.

9. No taxi licensee shall suffer, allow or permit a radio scanner or any device capable of monitoring the radio signals of any other taxi licensee to be installed or carried in any taxi or taxi office.

10. **Tariffs:**

No person shall operate a taxi or allow a taxi to be operated within the City unless there is posted at a location inside the taxi, so as to be clearly visible to passengers, a tariff card which shows the applicable fees and charges for taxi services including but not limited to:

- (a) Rates per flag
- (b) Rates per kilometer
- (c) Rates per waiting time or elapsed time
- (d) Flat rates or per trip rates

11. **Business License Fees and Permit Fees:**

- (a) Taxi Business License fee - \$110.00 per calendar year (or as established by by-law of the City from time to time)
- (b) Taxi Driver Permit fee - \$10.00 per calendar year (or as established by Camrose Police Service from time to time)

12. (a) Any person who contravenes any provision of this By-Law is guilty of an offence and liable upon Summary Conviction to a fine of not exceeding \$2,500.00.

(b) If a person charged with an offence under this ByLaw is alleged to have contravened a provision that is referred to in Schedule " C " attached to and forming this ByLaw, the minimum fine upon conviction by a court shall be the amount set out in Schedule " C " opposite the description of the offence, under the column entitled "Payment Acceptable in Lieu of Prosecution".

(c) Notwithstanding any other provisions for penalties in this ByLaw, a License Officer or Peace Officer may, in lieu of laying an Information in respect to the alleged breach, issue a voluntary penalty for each offense to the accused in respect to the said breach and the accused may within seven (7) days of the issuance of such ticket pay such amount.

(d) In the event the prescribed voluntary penalty is not paid within the time allotted herein the License Officer or Peace Officer may thereafter lay an Information in respect to the offense for which the voluntary penalty ticket was issued.

13. Any Peace Officer or License Officer who has reasonable grounds to believe that any person has contravened any provisions of this By-Law may:
  - (a) serve upon such person a summons for the breach of any Section stated in this Bylaw;
  - (b) serve upon such person an offence ticket allowing payment of the specified penalty for the breach of any other section of this By-Law, allowing the payment of the specified penalty to the City which shall be accepted by the City in lieu of prosecution for the offence;
  - (c) seize and take possession of any permits where the same are cancelled, suspended, or otherwise required to be returned to the City.
14. That Traffic By-Law #1754/92 as amended be further amended by deleting Sections 709, 710, and 711 therefrom.
15. This By-Law will come into force January 1st, 1997.
