NOISE ABATEMENT BY-LAW #2258/01
re: NOISE CONCERNS - MUNICIPAL FACILITIES:

MOTION #43/04 Moved by Minor - seconded by Shillington that Motion #29/04, as amended, be raised from the table.

MOTION CARRIED 8-0.

MOTION #29/04 Moved by Nielsen - seconded by Minor, as amended, that approval be granted to the implementation of a noise control policy at all indoor Municipal Facilities whereby amplified sound systems and the use of air horns or other mechanical equipment will be restricted in accordance with the City of Camrose Nuisance Abatement By-Law #2285/01, as amended, as a health and safety consideration for the patrons of the facility:

	<u>System Equipment</u>	<u>Restriction</u>
1.	Amplified sound systems	Restricted maximum of 95 decibels in all spectator areas.
2.	Facility Air Horns	Restricted to supervised air horn(s) only and maximum of 105 decibels in north spectator areas (10 second maximum duration).
3.	Other items or equipment with 105+ decibels	Prohibited
4.	Portable air/boat horns	Prohibited

Any unauthorized operation of amplified sound systems, air horns or other mechanical equipment exceeding the noise levels noted above or in a manner deemed to be nuisance as defined in By-Law #2258/01 shall be considered a contravention to By-Law #2258/01 and subject to the enforcement provisions and penalties with this By-Law.

This policy shall become effective September 1, 2004.
