SUBJECT: POLICY RE: Driveway from Public or Private Property to Public Roadways

RECOMMENDATION:

MOTION #49/85 Moved by Galenza, seconded by Fowler

that the following be adopted as policy for the issuance of permits for the creation of driveways.

CARRIED 7-0

Pursuant to Section 308 of the Camrose Property by-law #1353 which regulates the use of Streets, Sidewalks and Other Public Property within the City of Camrose, whereby a permit may be issued by the City Engineer for the creation or construction of a driveway along or across any boulevard or sidewalk. Approval of an application for a driveway from public or private property to public roadways is dependent upon the application meeting all of the following criteria:

- (a) a driveway providing access from public or private property to a roadway may be permitted if the driveway is required to provide direct access to a garage, carport or rear yard in conformance with the provision of the City of Camrose Land Use By-law, and
- (b) construction of the driveway will not unduly interfere with the flow and safety of vehicles or pedestrians, and
- (c) in the case of a driveway request on an arterial or collector roadway to which the province make financial assistance, approval of the Province must first be obtained prior to the issuance of a permit, and
- (d) construction of an approved driveway shall be at the owner's expense and in conformance with City Engineering Department specifications.
